

This term Year I will be learning about...



Our question we will be exploring throughout the Spring term is 'What mysteries belong to the sea?', which will focus on science, geography and the arts. Our outcome will be an art exhibition where children will demonstrate a variety of art skills. The children will answer questions such as :What are the seven seas and where in the world are they? Who has sailed our oceans and why? Are all the seas the same? Which creatures live in the sea? You could help your child at home by encouraging them to ask questions about any aspect of their learning they are unsure of, finding out more through their own research.



Maths -We will be learning about:

- Counting and recognising numbers to 50.
- Number addition & subtraction using numbers to 20 and applying at mastery level.
- Number bonds to 20.
- Recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes.
- Doubling and halving different objects and quantities. Measure.

You could help your child at home by encouraging them to take the opportunity to practise their calculation skills and by regularly practising 2s,5s and 10.

English

- Match graphemes for all phonemes.
- Read accurately by blending sounds.
- Make simple predictions and link to own experiences.
- Use finger spaces/ full stops/ capital letters/question marks.
- Use con junctions and/but/because.
- Spell year I key words accurately.

You could help your child at home by reading with them regularly and asking questions about the story and characters.

You can also support your child be supporting with revision for SATS test using the KS2 study guides.

PE This term in PE, children will learn how to play team games.

Religious Education— Exploring the questions— Why are stories from the Old Testament important to Christians?
