<p style="text-align: center;">Times tables practice</p> <p>Every day you should practice times tables on times table rock stars if possible. You should practice the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3 goes on garage (more if possible) - 3 goes on studio (more if possible) - At least 3 goes on soundcheck – more if possible. <p>If it is not possible to access the internet - we have printed some sheets off for you to practice.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spellings</p> <p>You should pick 1 to practice weekly. Each day you should copy them, then cover them and try to copy them from memory. Once a week your parents or older brothers or sisters should test you on them.</p> <p>-tion, -sion, -cian, -ssion.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ancient Egypt</p> <p>– our next topic includes an in-depth study into the ancient civilisation of Egypt. You could make a poster about one of the following areas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Why is the River Nile important to Egypt? ● Why did the Egyptians build pyramids? ● What is mummification and why were people mummified? ● Who were the Gods and Goddesses of Egypt?
<p style="text-align: center;">Fluent in 5</p> <p>We would like children to do 1 page a day of the fluent in 5 pack that we send home. This is to practice addition, subtraction, multiplication and division methods.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>We would like children to continue reading for 20 minutes each day.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Macbeth performance</p> <p>– We are sending home a new copy of the play script – please spend 15 minutes a day looking at your part and reading it aloud and practice it – we will do this when we return to school.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Rapid Reasoning</p> <p>We would like children to do 1 page a day of the rapid reasoning pack that we send home. This is to revisit topics we have already covered so the children are able to keep their recall of maths topics.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reading comprehension</p> <p>We would like children to complete 4 60 second reads each week. These are a short piece of text with 4 questions to answer. You could help your child by reading it to them first and then letting them read it back to you.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Iconic buildings</p> <p>– Our next topic is ‘What makes a Building Iconic?’ We would like children to research one of these buildings and make a poster telling is all about it.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Burj Khalifa ● The Shard ● Sydney Opera House ● Pyramids of Giza
