Returning to School

September 2020

Our new rules, routines and systems follow government guidance and are designed to minimise the risk of infection of COVID19.

They are put in place to help keep everyone within our school community safe.

September return

All children will be returning to school in September, full time.

Attendance is compulsory

Returning to school

- When you return to school things will look and feel a little different.
- All children, parents and staff will need to behave differently.
- We have a set of new school rules, systems and routines to help everyone adjust to the changes.

Routines for arrival or departure

Each year group will be given a specific time to arrive and leave school.

In the morning, parents will bring children to each class area on the yard and wait by the coloured cone. Teachers will be there waiting for you. Parents will then leave the school grounds.

Only 1 parent to bring children to school

Parents must leave the school grounds immediately to avoid too many people on site at once.

Parents will not be able to enter the school building.

At the end of the day, parents will collect children from the same coloured cone.

9.00am	2.40pm	You must use the entrance near Hucklow school office. Please follow the signage to the F2 entrance. Staff will meet you and take you around to the F2 provision. Children will be met by an adult and will go straight into the classroom. You will collect your child from the same entrance at the end of the day.


Y1

You will be met by an adult and will be taken to your classroom. Once you are in the line, parents must exit school following the signage. You will be collected from the same area at the end of the day.

8.30am	2.45pm	You will line up in the cricket area on the main playground, please follow the signage. You must line up near the WHITE cones. You will be met by an adult and will be taken to your classroom. Once you are in the line, parents must exit school following the signage. You will be collected from the same area at the end of the day.
		

- All entrances to school will be open.
- You must not stand around talking to other parents on the yard.
- Please contact the school office or let the teacher know if someone else is picking your child up.

Hygiene

Everyone will have to wash their hands at regular intervals.

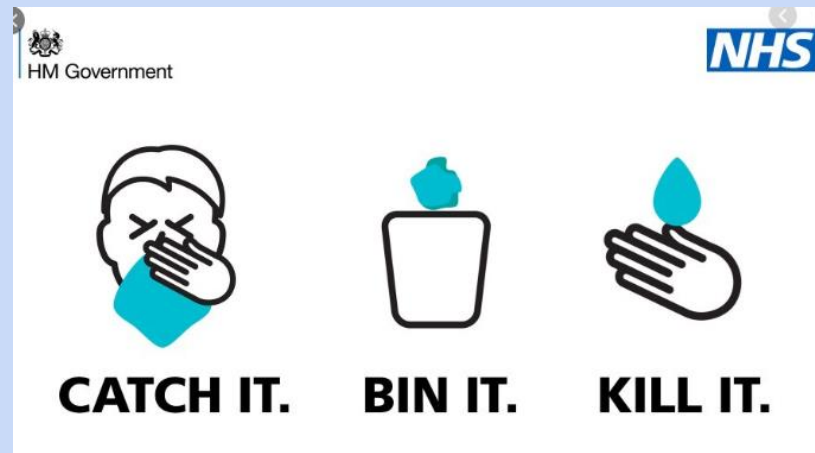
Hand sanitiser pumps are available at key points around school.

Everyone must sanitise their hands at entry and exit points.

All classrooms and communal areas will be cleaned twice daily.



Hygiene



If you sneeze or cough you need to use the 'Catch it, bin it, kill it' routine.

You will be encouraged and reminded to avoid touching your mouth, nose and eyes with hands.

Face Coverings

Children are not to wear face coverings in school.

Children wearing face coverings on the way to school must safely remove them before entering the building.

You will see staff wearing face coverings in communal areas such as corridors and staffroom.

Classes/bubbles

When you return to school you will be in your class, with all your friends. Your class will become your 'bubble'.

For the majority of the time you learn and play with your class 'bubble' however there will be times when you will be together as a year group bubble.

This means, if a staff member or child received a positive Covid result, the whole year group and staff from those bubbles would have to self isolate for 14 days.

Break times and lunchtimes

You will eat with your year group and where possible, play with your class bubble only.

Your bubble will have a designated area to eat and play.

Lunches

We will be offering a full menu from September- see next slides to view our new exciting menu. Thursday 3rd September will be week 1 menu.

Children will eat with children from their bubble only.

The dining room will be cleaned between sittings.

Food will be brought to the child- rather than children lining up at the hatch.

Moving around the school

You will only leave your classroom when necessary-
e.g lunch, break.

When you move around school you must try and
keep 2m distance from people in other bubbles.

Going to the toilet

You must ask permission to go to the toilet and your teaching assistant will supervise you.

You will need to sanitise your hands before entering the toilet and when you leave.

Equipment

- Teachers have prepared a set of resources for each child.
- You will need to bring
 - Water bottle (please fill up at home and take home to be cleaned each day)
 - Book bag- reading book and home learning book
 - Packed lunch- if you choose.
 - Trainers for PE.

Uniform

Children are expected to wear uniform in September.

- Black or grey trousers or skirt
- Grey pinafore or navy gingham dress
- Black shoes- no sandals
- White polo shirt
- Navy blue jumper or cardigan
- No jewellery- except for a watch.

Home Learning

If your child has to self isolate they will be provided with learning to complete at home.

This will be in the form of a learning pack and will be available online and as a paper copy if needed.

Illness

If a child is ill you need to contact the school office via telephone to inform us on the first day of absence.

If you believe your child is displaying Covid 19 symptoms, you need to arrange for them to be tested and follow government guidance-

Consequences for inappropriate behaviour

All pupils need to show respect for each other and the adults in school. Our school rules are there to keep us happy and safe. You are all expected to follow **RESPECT**

If a pupils chooses to behave in an inappropriate way they will

- Reflect on their behaviour and discuss solutions and consequences with the adults in their bubble (Post Incident Learning)

If behaviour becomes more serious and impacts on the safety of themselves and others the pupil will

- Be asked to leave the classroom and parents will be contacted
- A risk assessment will be undertaken and the pupil may have to go home
- The pupil may have to remain at home until their behaviour is safe enough to return to school
